How to Approach New Repertoire: Solutions for Successful Teaching
The early stages of teaching new repertoire are vital. Solutions for successful teaching of ten pieces in the standard piano teaching literature will be presented to develop technique and artistry for high quality student performances. Teaching pieces to be discussed include J. S. Bach's Minuet in G Major, BWV Anh. 114, CPE Bach's *Solfeggietto* in C Minor, H. 220, Clementi's Sonatina in C Major, Op. 36/1 (mvt. I), Mozart's Sonata in C Major, K. 545 (mvt. I), Heller's *The Avalanche*, Op. 45/2, Mendelssohn's *Venetian Boat Song*, Op. 19/6, Grieg's *Puck*, Op. 71/3, Schumann's "Child Sleeping" from *Kinderszenen*, Op. 15, Debussy's *Arabesque* No. 1, and Muczynski's Prelude Op. 6, No. 1.
